One of the United States' best-loved presidents, Abraham Lincoln, was also one of four presidents to be assassinated. Lincoln was the sixteenth president of the United States and is famous for ending slavery and ending the Civil War, a bloody war that threatened to break apart the United States. Lincoln also led great changes in the American economy and the role of the national government. But many people at the time, especially Southern men who did not support the outcome of the Civil War, did not like Lincoln's policies. One group of men led by the famous stage actor John Wilkes Booth planned the deaths of the president, the vice president, and the secretary of state so the Southern states could break from the American government.
